The most defining moment for XISS in the year 2022-23 has been receiving of the NBA Accreditation from the National Board of Accreditation for all the 4 Programmes of XISS. XISS was also awarded the 'Excellence in Social Responsibility-2022' in the Higher Education Summit organized by Collegedunia Connect. It gives me immense pleasure in informing all that XISS was ranked 9th in Eastern Region and 27th in Top B-School (Private) by Fortune India B-School Survey 2022. We also were 57th among Top private institutions and 5th in East Zone Private Institutions by INDIA Today 2022 and held 52nd position in the Top 150 private institutions by TIMES Annual B-School Survey 2022. 14th position in Super-Excellence among Top B-schools (Private) in CSR-GHRDC Rankings 2022 was also awarded to XISS.

Placements are our key highlighting feature and there was an all-time high placement this year. Till date 95.51% students have been placed, of whom 92.65% are from HRM, 93.55% from RM, 98.33% from Marketing Management, and 98.18% from Financial Management. The Highest Package this year is Rs. 20.50 lakhs per annum, while 10 PPOs were accepted by the students. Most of the Summer Internships for Batch 2021-23 were with stipend & PPO facility (Highest Stipend was Rs. 1,20,000/- per month). A record 139 Companies / Organizations participated in the Campus Recruitment process where 49 of those Companies / Organizations came to the Campus for the First Time.

253 students graduate at XISS's 62nd Annual Convocation

Sampark (XISS-UNICEF Collaboration)

A follow-up MR vaccination campaign refers to a mass campaign for the routine immunization programme organized as periodic every 3 –5 years. Children between 9 months to <15 years of age were targeted for the vaccine. SBCC DPCs of Giridih, Sahibganj, Godda, Dumka, Deoghar, Pakur and Jamtara were the key person who took over the charge of coordination, facilitation, liaising, monitoring, and follow-up with district officials. For two months, they dedicatedly worked on a communication plan and simultaneous visits to schools, and health centres to monitor and facilitate and display of posters, banners, and leaflets so that the goal of the program could be achieved – 'To quickly make the children immune from measles and rubella'. The DPCs with this rigorous work have not forgotten the vision and mission of the project – SAMPARK III, efforts in preparing a communication plan and visits to schools, and communities to sensitize about ending child marriage and ending violence against children by showing videos which can change the thought process of the communities.
